Enrollment Information 2019-2020

Saluda County School District is excited to launch online registration for the 2019-2020 school year for both new and returning students. Please note that online registration is replacing the paper forms that have traditionally been filled out at the beginning of each school year. Additional information is outlined below regarding registration for “Returning Students” and “New Students.” Parents and guardians must complete a separate registration form for each child who will be attending Saluda County School District during the 2019-2020 school year. All students should be registered online prior to the Schedule Pick-up event on August 1st from 8:00am until 6:00pm.

RETURNING STUDENTS

Students who attended a Saluda County school for 2018 -2019 will register using the “Returning Student Registration” portal on this site under the “quick links” section. In order to complete the registration process, parents of returning students will need to have their child’s “snapcode.” Please refer to the letter attached to your child’s report card. (Every child has a unique snapcode.) If you have misplaced your snapcode letter or did not receive one please call Saluda School District Technology Department at 864-992-0523 for assistance. Parents will pay all student fees and pick up class schedules on August 1st at their child’s school during the registration event from 8:00am until 6:00pm.

NEW STUDENTS

Students who are new or did not attend the school district in 2018-2019 will register using the “New Student Registration” portal link in the “quick links” section of this site. Parents of new students will not need a “snapcode” in order to complete the online registration. Please visit your child’s new school on August 1st with the following documentation, as your child will not be enrolled without them.

1. State or Military Birth Certificate from the Bureau of Vital Statistics
2. South Carolina Certificate of Immunization (available from the Health Department or doctor’s office)
3. The following documents will be required at each school in order to register the student: Two proofs of Saluda County residency with the parents’ or guardians’ name and street address (not PO Box). Acceptable documentation: property tax bill, property insurance bill, mortgage statement, rental lease agreement, vehicle tax registration, voter registration card, electric bill, water bill, telephone bill, cable/satellite/internet bill, payroll stub, or bank statement.
4. Parent picture ID with same address.
